Where can you book a female doctor?

Outpatient Clinics

If you wish to see a female doctor in our outpatient clinics, it is best to call and book ahead to see if this can be arranged. To book please call the following clinics during business hours:

Where a female doctor is not available, a female midwife or nurse can be with you during the examination.

If you must see a female doctor and the clinic you need does **not** have a female doctor, we may need to send you back to your GP for a referral to go elsewhere.

Emergency Department, Maternity Services and Fetal Monitoring

In these departments female and male staff work closely together in teams. Each team member has a specialised role and could be either male or female. For this reason, there are some days where it may be more difficult to see a female doctor.

If your doctor is male, you can rest assured because:

- Staff will make sure that a female midwife or nurse is present during your examination
- You can have a friend or family member with you during his examination.

Operating Theatre

In our operating theatres, male and female staff work closely together in teams. During an operation, there is usually a female nurse present. However, we are unable to ensure you have only female doctors and/or anaesthetists.
