

## Your important health information

# Vagifem or ovestin instructions

You have been advised to use low dose oestrogen cream or pessaries to help in your next procedure.

These come in two forms:

- a vaginal cream called ovestin
- a vaginal pessary called vagifem.

You will need a prescription. Your doctor will give you this.

You need to follow the instructions.

- 1. Start using the cream or tablet four weeks before your appointment.
- 2. The cream or vaginal tablet is put into the vagina.
- 3. Use the applicator to do this.
- 4. Use the cream or vaginal tablet three times a week.
- 5. It should be used at night.
- 6. Use the medication for the last time two night before your appointment.
